Are you 18 or older and interested in a career in the electrical field? Apply for the **Registered Electrical Apprenticeship Preparation (REAP) Program** - a **4 week, paid pre-apprenticeship** offered in partnership with **Amteck**, the **American Job Center**, and the **Northwest TN Workforce Board starting June 1st**. You'll earn **\$16/hour** while learning the **fundamentals of basic electricity** and **construction skills** through hands-on training and classroom instruction.

To be considered for this program you must have a current and valid drivers license.

Throughout the program, Amteck will evaluate participants based on their willingness to undergo drug testing, punctuality, attitude, safety practices, and readiness for the electrical trade. Those who successfully complete the program are eligible to enroll in Amteck's **4-year Registered Apprenticeship**, a **U.S. Department of Labor-recognized program** that includes paid on-the-job training and online coursework. Apprentices may travel for job assignments on construction sites across the country. Upon completion of the 4-year program, Apprentices are prepared to take the **Journeyman/Licensed Electrician** exam, with the potential to earn **wages above the national average**.

Requirements:

- Must be able to attend the full training period
- Willingness to learn, work hard, and arrive on time
- Must have your own form of reliable transportation and be willing to travel to work locations
